Show News


At this time, we have notified the Grounds of our intentions to pass on signing a contract for our show in March of 2021. Signing a contract would obligate us to non refundable deposits we would lose, should the state lock downs continue into March. Without participation of our "at risk" volunteers, it would make it difficult for us to staff a show. Without a good attendance, it would reduce the likely return for our effort. If distancing mandates are in place, we could only accommodate half of our vendors in the older buildings we use for our show. Without the sale of table space, we would not generate enough funds to cover the facility rental contract.

As you may know, the great Tucson Gem and Mineral Society Show has been cancelled this year for the same reasons. All other Tucson shows have now been postponed to April 8th, due to the recent COVID concerns.

As of this time, (Dec. 27th), the Quartzsite shows are still on, as most of these shows are outside venues.

We have discussed the possibility of a "Monster Tailgater", later this year if the COVID restrictions ease up. We will let you know if that forms up as our "show" for this year!

Reminders have been e-mailed to those RRR members who have not sent in their renewal dues for 2021.


Please note, that if we don't receive your renewal payment for 2021, the January RRR bulletin will be the last one sent to you.



Examples:

REMEMBER THIS! Do Not Put water filled stones, such as opals, in the freezer to remove the cab from the dopstick. The water will freeze and crack the stone.The Tumble Rumble

Cold dop with Elmer's Glue. It is always ready and will dry enough to begin work in 30 to 40 minutes. It seldom lets loose, even on a rough wheel. The warmer the stone gets, the tighter it holds. To remove the stone from the dop stick, drop it all in water and leave for several hours.The Agatizer

TO CLEAN QUARTZ CRYSTALS — Amethyst also— Cover them with fresh vinegar to remove the carbonates. Allow to stand overnight. Repeat if necessary. Wash well, then place them in washing-type ammonia for 8 to 12 hours. Remove, rinse well and air dry. As vinegar is an acid DO NOT PUT IT ON the Crystal Centers of SEPTARI-AN NODULES! The vinegar will eat away the inside material.CFMS Newsletter

ALUMINUM PENCILS will give you a good idea of the HARDNESS of STONES. The harder the stone, the fainter the mark it will make. It won't mark a stone harder than 7.The Agatizer

EPOXY -- The rock, stone, or other object should be very clean before using epoxy. Alcohol is very good in most instances because it dries quickly. When applied to BELL CAPS, it should be used sparingly but enough to hold securely. A good idea is to use a BOX OF SAND about an inch and a half deep and FLORISTS CLAY to hold the stones in position until the epoxy sets. Hold the bell cap with tweezers while applying the epoxy. 
